**ORDER ON MOTION TO COMPEL WIFE'S CONFIDENTIAL MEDICAL  
INFORMATION**

On February 23, 2019, this Court heard Petitioner, **ALLISON GELBE-PINKUS'** *Motion for Confidentiality Order* seeking the entry of a protective order governing documents produced in this action and other documents, information, or testimony provided in connection with pretrial proceedings or trial of this action. After considering the Motion, the evidence presented, and the arguments of counsel for both parties this Court finds that the Petitioner is entitled to all relief sought in her Motion, as follows:

The Court finds that the Intensive Outpatient Treatment records are confidential and privileged under TRE 509 and TRE 510; that Petitioner never waived her privilege as to the IOP records; that the life coach records are confidential and privileged under TRE 510 because Petitioner had a reasonable belief that the life coach was licensed or certified; life coach records are confidential and privileged under TRE 510 because the records deal with an emotional condition as defined by TRE 510; that Petitioner never waived her privilege as to the life coach records; that the Respondent has not met his burden of proving the litigation exception applies to any of Petitioner's medical records, drug addiction records, counseling records, or life coach records; that the clerk of the court should mark all medical records and pleadings as sensitive and containing confidential information and place them under seal, that the deposition of Petitioner is complete and shall not be resumed; that Respondent's offensive questions violated Petitioner's privilege, are quashed and Petitioner's objections to them sustained.
